START LISTS: Start lists will be posted on Zone4 and be available Saturday morning after 8:30 a.m. at the bib pickup.

BIB PICKUP: Bib pickup for the race will be at the Nechako Valley Sporting Association Clubhouse 6 km West of Vanderhoof (turn North on Redmond Pit Road and follow the  signs) between 9:00 a.m. and 10:15 a.m. on Saturday, February 19, 2022.

Bibs must be picked up by 10:15 a.m.

AWARDS: An awards ceremony will be held on site following the race. In addition to the medals there will be **lots** of draw prizes to give away!

TEAM AGGREGATE AWARDS:

Club points are accumulated for each skier who successfully completes the race. Cross Country BC will post the aggregate points earned by participating clubs as they accumulate throughout the season. The winner of the Club Aggregate Award will be the club with the most points. **As this is the 6th and last race in the TECK Northern Cup the Club Aggregate Award will be presented immediately after the race has been completed!**

Details	Points
No. of participants in an interval start race	1 point per participant
Top 5 placing in each category	7 (for first place), 6, 5, 4, 3 points
If there are less than five competitors in a category, the points will still begin at 7 points for 1 st place, 6 points for 2 nd place, etc.	

COVID RESTRICTIONS:

As COVID requirements may change, please note that the Nechako Nordics will follow the latest Northern Health protocols on race day.

CLUBHOUSE USE:

A Clubhouse with washrooms is located adjacent to the Nechako Valley Sporting Association trails. Unfortunately, due to COVID concerns the Clubhouse will be used for essential purposes only:

- Masks must be worn in the Clubhouse.
- The Clubhouse cannot be used as a gathering spot as it has been in the past.
- To avoid congestion, you will need to enter the Clubhouse from the North door and exit via the South door.
- Use of the clubhouse will be restricted to essential warm up and bathroom use only.
We ask all users to restrict essential Clubhouse use to 15 minutes or less

PARKING: There is limited parking adjacent to the Nechako Valley Sporting Association clubhouse. Overflow parking is available along Quail Drive (the access road to the Nechako Valley Sporting Association trails).

WAXING: Participants should come to the race with skis already waxed as there are limited power outlets available for waxing. Due to COVID concerns, the Clubhouse waxing stations are not available for use.

WARM UP/WAX TESTING: A warm up area will be available in the vicinity of the race start.

COURSES: Course maps for all the race categories will be posted outside the clubhouse on race day.

CONCESSION: Due the present COVID concerns there will be no concession offered this year.

CANCELLATION: There are no refunds of any kind once a racer registers and then subsequently withdraws from the race or does not show up for the race. If the organizers are required to cancel the race due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances, then full refunds will be issued except for any online processing fees.

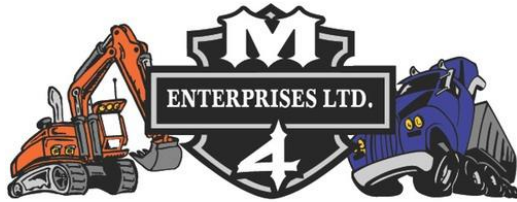
