21st Annual School Ski Championships Friday, February 10, 2017

What: Cross Country ski races!! Either classic or freestyle technique allowed. A main event race plus Junior and Open relays, fun relays and cash sprints!

When: Friday February 10, 2017. Bib Pickup 10:00 a.m. Main race starts 11:00 a.m. sharp!!

Where: Don Allen Ski Trails, 20 km north of La Ronge on Highway 102 at the Nemeiben Lake Road junction

Note: The School Ski Championships event focuses on school ski groups. However, the Championship is a Sask Cup event, and it is open to entries from ALL skiers regardless of age. The event will accept entries from individuals who are not part of a school ski group, and those individuals will be able to earn Sask Cup points if they are licensed racers.

Relays: In addition to the main race event, there will be competitive team relays.

In the Junior Relay, schools are invited to field a team of 4 skiers who will each ski a 200-metre loop. A Junior Relay Team must consist of 2 girls and 2 boys from the same school in the Midget category or younger.

In the Open Relay, schools are invited to field a team of 4 skiers who will each ski a 460-metre loop. An Open Team must consist of 2 girls and 2 boys from the same school. Skiers can be from any age class. Schools will be allowed to enter more than one team.

Cash Sprints: There will be fun, short distance cash sprints held in the stadium just prior to the awards ceremony for racers under the age of 18. \$10.00 for 1st and \$5.00 for 2nd. A good chance to win some cash!

Awards: 1st, 2nd, & 3rd place ribbons and participation ribbons will be awarded in all age categories of the main event. Other good prizes too! Gold banners will be awarded to the top schools in both a “large school” and a “small school” categories based on participation points. Banners will also be awarded to schools winning the Junior Relay and Open Relay.

Food: Free hot dogs, cookies and drinks will be served at the end of the race.

Entry: Entry fee is \$5.00 per skier. Cost for team relays is \$10.00 per team.

Online Registration: All school skiers and individual skiers **must register online** by going to www.zone4.ca. To find the School Ski Championships search zone4 using the search function. Search for “Saskatchewan School Ski Championships 2017” to bring up the School Ski Championship’s registration form. Click on the form and then click on “Add First Person” to begin registering skiers. **Registration will be available from 9:00 a.m. Tuesday January 24 until 4:00 p.m. Wednesday February 8th, 2017.**

Payment of Fees: Fees do not have to be paid online. All fees (being the \$5.00 for each individual skier and \$10.00 for each relay team) are to be paid by cheque made payable to “Northern Sport, Culture & Recreation” with the cheques to be paid to the Race Office at the Don Allen Trails by 10:00 a.m. on race day.

Entry Deadline: The **deadline for entries is Wednesday, February 8th, 2017 at 4:00 p.m.** All entries must be made online.

Waiver: The online registration process requires that skiers agree to the term of a “Cross Country Canada Informed Consent and Assumption of Risk Agreement” waiver. That form is attached to this Race Notice. Teachers registering students can use the attached form to obtain parental/guardian consent allowing a student to participate.

Relay Team Registration: To register school relay teams, schools must send a list of team participants (showing name, date of birth and gender) to Dean Squires at deansquires25@gmail.com no later than Wednesday, February 8th, 2017 at 4:00 p.m. Relay teams must be registered in advance in order to compete.

Bib Pick-Up: Bibs are to be picked up by school coaches/chaperones at the Don Allen Trails by 10:00 a.m. Coaches/chaperones will be responsible for distributing bibs to the skiers in their groups as set out in a list to be provided by the race organizers.
